

DIRECTIONS

Roadside Willies Smokehouse & Bar is ideally located in Central Nova Scotia within a few minutes drive of Exit 17 from Provincial Highway 104 (Trans Canada Highway). If you get lost, call 902-843-3486 and we'll get you found!

For visitors traveling from the city of Halifax or the Halifax International Airport, or for those visitors connecting from the Lighthouse or Evangaline Trails, take Highway 102 northbound to its intersection with Highway 104 near Truro. Exit eastbound (Exit 15E) onto Highway 104 toward New Glasgow and Cape Breton. On Highway 104 take Exit 17 to Bible Hill. At the bottom of the ramp turn right and proceed 300 meters to a set of lights. Turn right onto Highway 4 East (Pictou Road) and proceed exactly 4 km until you see Jennifer Drive on your right. Look for Tim Hortons on the left side as it is almost directly across from Jennifer Drive. Turn right onto Jennifer Drive and you will see Roadside Willies on the left. The restaurant is attached to a large dome shaped bowling alley.

For visitors traveling eastbound from the New Brunswick/Nova Scotia Border along Highway 104 (Trans Canada Highway), take Exit 17 to Bible Hill. At the bottom of the ramp turn right and proceed 300 meters to a set of lights. Turn right onto Highway 4 East (Pictou Road) and proceed exactly 4 km until you see Jennifer Drive on your right. Look for Tim Hortons on the left side as it is almost directly across from Jennifer Drive. Turn right onto Jennifer Drive and you will see Roadside Willies on the left. The restaurant is attached to a large dome shaped bowling alley.

For visitors traveling westbound from Cape Breton or connecting at Pictou via the ferry from Prince Edward Island, take Highway 104 westbound to Exit 17, Bible Hill and Truro. At the bottom of the ramp turn left and proceed exactly 4.5 km until you see Jennifer Drive on your right. Look for Tim Hortons on the left side as it is almost directly across from Jennifer Drive. Turn right onto Jennifer Drive and you will see Roadside Willies on the left. The restaurant is attached to a large dome shaped bowling alley.
